Do you take things apart and put them back together just to see how they work? Do you always have the right tool for the job? Maybe becoming a millwright is the right path for you. Millwrights work on construction sites and in factories assembling and disassembling machinery. This work can involve intricate technical repairs and heavy machining tools, depending on the project. Millwrights have to be able to understand technical manuals for many different types of machines as well as have a high level of problem solving skills.

BRCC TAACCCT Millwright Training Program Overview

The BRCC TAACCCT Millwright Training Program uses the National Center for Construction Education and Research (NCCER) Curriculum to provide no cost training to eligible individuals. Participants will receive training at no cost in NCCER Core Curriculum, Millwright Level 1 and Millwright Level 2. The BRCC TAACCCT Millwright Training Program will also use embedded Adult Education instruction to provide participants with basic skill support and GED preparation.

To be considered eligible, you must fit into one of the following categories: Unemployed, Underemployed, Veteran, or Trade Affected Worker. All eligible participants will take the TABE test to determine academic level. Eligible participants that test below certain grade levels must attend Skills Enhancement classes. Classes will be held Monday— Thursday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Skills Enhancement Class will be held Fridays from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

February 17—March 13, 2014: NCCER Millwright Level 1; The NCCER Millwright Level 1 Certificate will be awarded upon successful completion

March 17—April 24, 2014: NCCER Millwright Level 2; The NCCER Millwright Level 2 Certificate Credential will be awarded upon successful completion
