

**PUBLIC NOTICE
OF AVAILABILITY FOR PUBLIC INSPECTION OF
THE ANNUAL OPERATING AND CAPITAL BUDGETS
FISCAL YEAR 2018-2019

The Mayor and Council of the City of Baker, LA met in regular session on May 22, 2018, a proper quorum being there and then assembled, at which time Ordinances 2018-21, 2018-22, 2018-23, 2018-24, 2018-25 and 2018-26, implementing the Annual Budgets of Revenues and Expenditures for the General Fund, Special Revenue Funds, Capital Budget and Capital Program of Governmental Funds, Utility Fund and Utility Capital Improvements Fund, Cemetery Fund and Cemetery Capital Improvements Fund, Sewer Fund and Sewer Capital Improvements Fund, were introduced.

The Proposed Budgets of Revenues and Expenditures will be available for public inspection at the Mayor's Office located at 3325 Groom Road, Baker, Louisiana, during normal working hours from May 23, 2018 until their adoption on July 10, 2018.

A Public Meeting will be held on June 12, 2018 at the regular Council meeting at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers located at 3325 Groom Road, Baker, LA, in accordance with the rules of conduct of the Baker City Council meetings and the open meetings laws that require allotted time for public comments before every vote is taken (R.S. 42:11-28) at which time public comment will be invited.

Amendments (alterations, additions, deletions) may be made until the regular Council meeting on June 26, 2018 at 6:00 p.m., when, in accordance with Louisiana State Law, the budget will be presented in its final form, and placed on inspection in that form for 15 days until the Council meeting of July 10, 2018, when the ordinance and budgets will be finally adopted.

A final Public Meeting will be held for the purposes of Public Information and adoption of the Ordinances 2018-21, 2018-22, 2018-23, 2018-24, 2018-25 and 2018-26 at the regular Council meeting on July 10, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers located at 3325 Groom Road, Baker, LA, in accordance with the rules of conduct of the Baker City Council meetings and the open meetings laws that require allotted time for public comments before every vote is taken (R.S. 42:11-28) at which time public comment will be invited.
