



# What should I do if I have Medicaid and I want to be tested for Covid-19?

## Do I have Medicaid?

If you have insurance through Aetna Better Health, AmeriHealth Caritas Louisiana, Healthy Blue, Louisiana Healthcare Connections or United Healthcare-Community Plan this means you are insured by one of the 5 Medicaid Managed Care organizations. You may also be insured directly through Medicaid (known as Fee for Service Medicaid).at means you have Medicaid.

### Who is at risk for Covid-19?

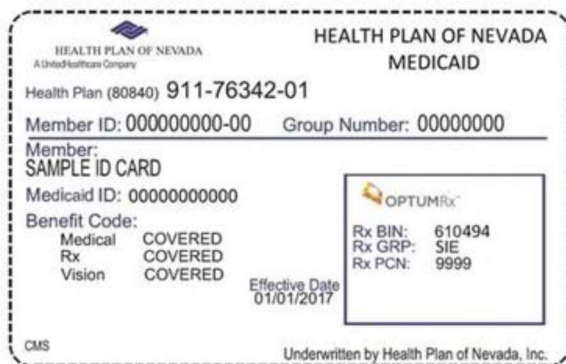
*People who are over the age of 60 or have underlying respiratory conditions. If you have a fever, cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing. Also if you have been in contact with someone who has been diagnosed with Covid-19, or visited Orleans or Jefferson parish within the last 14 days.*

### What should I do if I have symptoms?

**Stay at home and Call your doctor.**

### What if I don't have a doctor?

If you don't know who your doctor is, your Medicaid plan will know. If you cannot locate your doctor's name or number on your health plan card, call your health plan. Their numbers are listed below.

- ✓ Cover your nose and mouth when sneaking
  - ✓ Do not touch your face
- ✓ Clean and disinfect commonly touched surfaces
  - ✓ Stay and home if you feel sick
