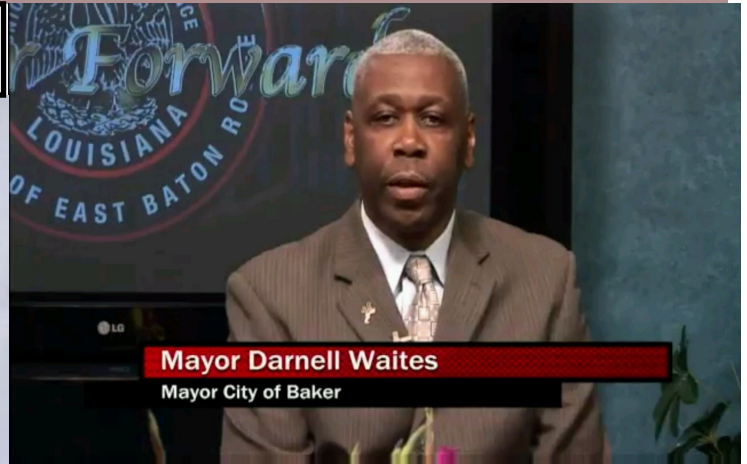

The City of Baker has begun partnerships to work through the NOAH Program to bring some relief and assistance to homeowners while also aiding in the rental development of some single-family home-ownership units. The NOAH Program (Non-Profit Open-Cycle Affordable Housing) is administered by the Louisiana Housing Corporation (LHC) which allows experienced non-profit housing development organizations to submit applications for new small housing development projects.

More information will be forthcoming on how to qualify for the program. This information will also include eligible projects in two categories, homeownership and rental development. Some of the required documentation applicants are responsible for by providing; by-laws; certificate of incorporation; current articles of incorporation; list of board members along with their occupations. 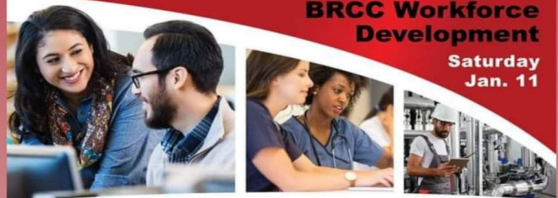
