

## **ORDINANCE 2022-16**

### **AN ORDINANCE TO RENAME HILCREST MEMORIAL GARDENS to NORMAN E. "PETE" HEINE MEMORIAL GARDENS UPON HIS DEATH**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of Baker, Parish of East Baton Rouge, State of Louisiana, in regular session assembled, a proper quorum being there and then assembled on September 13, 2022 that Ordinance 2022-14 is hereby Enacted as follows, to-wit:

#### **SECTION 1:**

In Honor of and in Recognition of his decades of Servant Leadership, Tireless Dedication and Selfless Sacrifices on behalf of and for the benefit of the citizens of the City of Baker, Louisiana;

#### **SECTION 2:**

In Recognition of and in Honor of his visionary acquisition on behalf of the City of Baker the cemetery property currently known as Hillcrest Memorial Gardens in the Year of Our LORD circa 1985 while serving as Mayor of the City of Baker;

#### **SECTION 3:**

**THEREFORE**, In the spirit of Honoring and Perpetuating his Legacy of Servant Leadership, Vision, Tireless Dedication and Selfless Sacrifice, It is Hereby Resolved, Determined, Decided and Declared that forthwith subsequent to his departure from his earthly life by death, whenever that may be, the **Hillcrest Memorial Gardens** in the City of Baker, Louisiana shall be officially Re-Named **NORMAN E. "PETE" HEINE MEMORIAL GARDENS**.

#### **SECTION 4: REPEAL**

All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby Repealed.

All Ordinances not in conflict herewith and not affected by the Amendments and Supplements hereinabove set forth are hereby maintained in full force and effect as if Re-Enacted herein.

The Repeal of an Ordinance shall not affect any punishment or penalty incurred before the Repeal took effect, or any suit, prosecution or proceedings pending at the time of the Repeal, for an offense committed under the Ordinance Repealed.

#### **SECTION 5: SEVERABILITY**

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the Baker City Council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, or sections of this Ordinance, since the same would have been Enacted by the Baker City Council without the incorporation in this Ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrases, clauses, sentence, paragraph or section. If the provisions of this Ordinance, or the application thereof to any person, fact, situation or circumstance are held invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance and the application of such provisions to the other persons, facts, situations or circumstances, shall not be affected thereby.

**SECTION 6: INVALIDATION**

If any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or applications and, to that end, any and all provisions of this Ordinance and applications thereof are declared to be severable.
