NEW BUSINESS

1. Update on quality and fair housing in the City of Baker for all tenants, landlords and homeowners (Bryant)

Mission Statement

- A. To provide a healthy lifestyle through community gardens and exercise availability.
- B. To provide a safe environment through communication with each other & law enforcement Police and Fire Departments.
- C. To provide our neighborhoods quality representation of integrity and tenacity.

Council Member Bryant read the mission statement and said she has seen it come to fruition. She provided an overview of her eight-year tenure and various accomplishments as a member of the Baker City Council. Council Member Bryant spoke about the need for community leaders to do better with regards to providing a positive, supportive, and safe environment for those students attending Baker schools. She reiterated the importance of keeping the children in our community safe and advocated, again, for a process that

includes background checks for those individuals working with students. She also addressed attacks made on her character and integrity, saying not only were they unappreciated, but patently untrue. She provided an update on the house on Gwendolyn with the infestation issue and dogs in the rear yard. Council Member Bryant implored the administration to address blighted properties in the City of Baker, saying that such areas are breeding grounds for rodents and snakes, and pose a health risk for residents as well.

2. Charter provision for appointments to boards (membership) and council concurrence (Vincent)

Council Member Vincent asked that council members, and citizens alike, read the city's charter. He stated he has spoken with the Mayor and his concerns regarding council participation in appointments to boards will be addressed at the upcoming retreat for new council members.

Council Member Vincent commended the Mayor for his appearance on CBS news. He announced the city has received a grant from Keep Louisiana Beautiful which will provide for putting up cameras throughout the city to catch those engaged in illegal dumping. Council Member Vincent reminded everyone to join him in picking up litter at your home, in your neighborhood, and throughout the city every third Saturday, and urged residents to avail themselves of the literature regarding litter from Keep Louisiana Beautiful. He stated the library has everything needed to pick up litter in the community including grabbers, gloves, and bags. These items must be checked out in order to use them.

Council Member Dunn thanked the Mayor for his efforts to beautify Main Street.

Council Member Bryant stated she will continue to pray for everyone and the City of Baker. She said she is happy that she will no longer be a part of an organization with no real leadership or direction, one content to be stagnant, one that seemingly operates by making it up as it goes along. Council Member Bryant closed by saying, "We live in a time when intelligent people are silenced, so that stupid people won't be offended."

Council Member Young said it's summertime and once again the city is having a problem with people riding ATVs. He asked that residents speak up, as this is an incredibly dangerous situation given their failure to obey traffic laws. He stated that things in our community are moving forward, and the school system is making strides. Council Member Young commended Cynthia Grimes for the program for teens she hosted over the weekend, saying she did a great job. He said it indeed takes a village to raise children. He announced he has copies of a book, entitled *How it Works*, which teaches kids about finances available for anyone who would like one. Council Member Young asked about the status of the blue building on Main Street and asked that the grass be cut.

Council Member Jackson announced District 63 Representative Dr. Barbara West Carpenter will host a back-to-school giveaway on August 3, 2024, at the City of Baker school board office. The event will begin at 11:00 a.m. She reminded everyone that individuals have a right to express themselves, whether you agree with them or like what they say, they have the right. She also asked that everyone make every effort to express themselves in a manner that facilitates passionate, yet peaceful, dialogue.
