ORDINANCE 2025-9 AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE CAPITAL BUDGET AND CAPITAL PROGRAM OF GOVERNMENTAL FUNDS FOR CITY OF BAKER, LOUISIANA FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL of the City of Baker, Parish of East Baton Rouge, Louisiana, in regular session assembled, a proper quorum being there and then assembled, on the 24th day of June 2025, as follows, to wit:

SECTION 1: The attached and detailed summary of the Capital Budget and Capital Program of Governmental Funds shall be and the same is hereby adopted to serve as the Capital Budget and Capital Program of Governmental Funds for the City of Baker, Parish of East Baton Rouge, State of Louisiana for fiscal year July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026.

SECTION 2: The adoption of the Capital Budget and Capital Program of Governmental Funds as reflected in the attached line-item budget containing object of expenditure classifications shall be declared to be the appropriation for the amounts set therein as established in each budget classification by object of expenditure.

SECTION 3: Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit the governing authority from amending or making an appropriation to and for a contingent fund to be used in cases of emergency.

SECTION 4: That the Clerk of Council shall cause this Ordinance together with the summary of the Capital Budget and Capital Program of Governmental Funds for Fiscal Year 2025-2026, to be published once in the official journal of the City of Baker, Louisiana.
